Supplemental Instruction (SI)

Supplemental instruction is a program that targets "high-risk" courses rather than "high-risk" students. The SI review sessions are interactive, and students acquire effective study strategies as they review course material and prepare for tests using mock exams. Statistical data suggest that students who attend SI sessions score 1/2 to a full letter grade higher than those who choose not to attend.
