SUBJECT: Summer Student Employment Information

Additional summer student employment information:

- 1. Summer2023student employment can start as early as SurAdparyl, 30 and end Saturday August 19 for up to 16 weeks. Eigible students may work 40 hours per week and generally work 14 weith additional weeks of unpaid time off, but departments can work with students on the total start as early as SurAdparyl, 30 and end Saturday August 19 for up to 16 weeks.
- 2. All summer student workers, including current student employees and ummoner student employees, must be processed and approved for hire by submitting a hiring propriation jobs.messiah.edu systemMarch 31, 2023
- 3. Departments are encouraged to request/select continuing academic year students prior to the job fair to have a accurate count of all open positions.
- 4. All summer postings must be 'posted/not visible' for two weeks after the job fair. During that time, only job fair attendees will be given access (via the URL) to summer job openings. Departments must contact Student Employment if a public posting is needed after two weekstical summer departments, including Campus Events, Dining Services and Conference & Event Services may request a public posting prior to the two weeks.

- 16. Room and board charges are based on start and end dates submitted in the hiring proposal.
